



Council Construction Commencing

Bushland Beach Naturalisation Channel Works

Works location: Peggy Banfield Park, Bushland Beach

Flyer delivery date: Friday, 31 May 2024

Council will recommence the naturalisation channel works within Peggy Banfield Park as follows:

Road/Street: **Bushland Beach Naturalisation Channel** adjacent to Peggy Banfield Park.

Works boundaries: Mount Low Parkway and Lionel Turner Drive.

Recommencement date: **Friday, 7 June 2024**

Duration: **Two (2) months** to complete, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Normal work hours are **6am to 5pm Monday to Friday** and **6am to 2pm on Saturday**. In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering well-maintained infrastructure and efficient transportation systems, with over \$400 million being invested in roads and transport management, open spaces, water and wastewater management this financial year.

Council will be recommencing the Bushland Beach Naturalisation Channel renewal works.

Residents and businesses close to the works may experience some temporary construction impacts including:

- Traffic control and temporary path closures,
- Safety fencing for pedestrian and vehicles,
- Construction works in and around the drain and adjacent footpaths
- Large construction machinery, noise and flashing lights.
