UPDATE: Riverway Drive Water Main Replacement

What works are coming up?

Council is moving forward with the replacement of an aging 100mm diameter water main along the eastern Riverway Drive footpath. At this stage, workers have successfully replaced the main pipe from Yut Fey Avenue to just north of the Jennifer Street intersection. The next section of pipe to be replaced is from Maud Street intersection to Yut Fey Avenue.

When will the works take place?

Location	Riverway Drive, Kelso
Timing	From Tuesday 8 October 2024 and is expected to be completed in May 2025, weather and project conditions permitting.
Hours	Normal work hours are from 6am to 6pm Monday to Saturday . In exceptional cases, work may be required outside these hours.

What will the works include?

As part of this project, Council will in stages:

- Excavate and install a temporary onground poly water pipe to maintain water supply to houses
- Excavate and remove the existing aging water main
- Construct a new 100mm diameter water main including new water connections and fire hydrants.

Funding

This project is funded by Townsville City Council.

What does this mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may experience:

- Occasional loss of water supply from 9am to 3pm. Additional advanced notification will be provided two days prior to the loss of water to your property.
- Construction machinery and vehicle movement
- Increased levels of dust, noise, and vibrations
- Temporary traffic changes, including lane closures, minor traffic delays and reduced speed limits.
