As part of the 2024/25 Budget, Townsville City Council is introducing changes to paid parking and plans to install paid parking meters along The Strand, Gregory, Mitchell, and Palmer Streets and in and around the Fulham Road medical precinct.

Before we begin construction activities, you may notice Council surveyors in the area. Their role is to mark the location of the new meters on the ground, which is a crucial step in preparing to install ground footings and locate underground services.

These activities may involve temporarily closing on-street parking bays, machinery operations, vehicle movements, lighting, and odours. We understand this may cause some inconvenience, and we appreciate your understanding and patience during this time.

Regular work hours are from **6am to 6pm, Monday through Saturday**. In exceptional cases, Council may need to work outside these hours.

Council is committed to keeping the community informed as this project's delivery progresses. We will continue to provide updates on our progress and any changes to the schedule.
