## Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant Pipeline Completion

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering well-maintained infrastructure and efficient transportation systems, with over \$400 million being invested in roads and transport management, open spaces, water, and wastewater management this financial year.

As part of this commitment, Council has **completed** the duplication of the **Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant pipeline**. The pipeline is a key water infrastructure asset essential to Townsville's water supply which provides 85% of the city's water. The newly completed pipeline will further enhance Townsville's water security into the future.

Construction started in July 2021 with Council and contractors working efficiently and tirelessly to ensure a successful delivery well ahead of schedule.

Water conservation measures in relation to this project are no longer required for the Townsville community and the Ross River between Black Weir, Thuringowa and Gollogly Lane, Rasmussen will open to all users on **Thursday 20 June**.
