Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant Revegetation Works

Works location: Ross River, Kelso

Townsville City Council is committed to delivering well-maintained infrastructure and efficient transportation systems, with over \$400 million being invested in roads and transport management, open spaces, water, and wastewater management this financial year.

The installation of the Ross River Dam to Douglas Water Treatment Plant pipeline is almost complete. This pipeline is crucial to Townsville's water supply which provides 85% of the city's water. As the project moves into its final stages, Council will work on rehabilitating areas affected by the pipeline construction activities.

Revegetation works are forecasted to commence on Riverway Drive and the Ross River crossing in **July** and be **completed by the end of August 2024**, weather permitting.

Residents and businesses near the revegetation area may experience some temporary impacts including:

- Noise
- Truck and heavy machinery movements
- Occasional dust.
